The event aims to serve the NSW and Australian Taekwondo Community on many levels:

- Create a prestigious and competitive event for younger players of all skill levels - to build athlete interest and encourage personal development in Taekwondo.
- Provide Open Black Belt competitors with the optimum competitive environment - encouraging athletes to maintain and improve the top tier standard.
- Host an event which is attractive to the general public, increasing public awareness and interest in Taekwondo.

Technical and Sparring events will be held in the Arena section of the Sydney Olympic Park Sports Centre. Doors open at 7:30am, competition commences at 9am.

All Open Black Belt Competition will use the Daedo Electronic Body Protector System.

Open Black Belt athletes will need Daedo Sensor Socks, which need to be purchased prior to the competition. The order form is attached at the end of this information pack.

Tickets for General Public Entry to the sparring event on Sunday will be available at the door.

Sparring Entry Fees: First Sparring Division - \$50
Additional Sparring Division - \$25
(for example a 16-17 years athlete who wants to compete in the Open division as well).

Technical Entry Fees: Individual Events - \$40
Pairs / Teams / Family events - \$30 per person

Technical Multi event discount:

Your first technical event is full price, all additional technical events cost \$20.



Technical Registration Fee Examples:

One individual entering Individual Poomse and Pair Poomse = \$60 (40 + 20)

One individual entering Individual Poomse, Team Poomse and Family Poomse = \$80
(40+20+20)

One individual entering Pair Poomse and Team Poomse = \$50 (30 + 20)

One individual entering Individual Poomse and Speed Kyupka = \$75 (40 + 20 + 15 for boards)

Entry into sparring competition has no bearing on technical entry fees (and vice versa).

Eligible Competitors: Registered members of Taekwondo Australia with Taekwondo Australia sports membership card.

Age Divisions: All competitors ages are **as at 31 December 2012** unless otherwise stated.

Tournament Rules: WTF Competition Rules
Sparring - *No head kicks* for 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13 age divisions.
No head kicks for Yellow Belts – Regardless of age.
A head kick, intentional or through lack of caution, will be treated as attacking the head with the fist or the hand. The appropriate penalties of Kyong-go (warning), Gamjeom (deduction point), or disqualification will apply.

Draw: A full list of competitors will be posted on-line www.tkdnsw.org.au on Sunday night March 11th, and is updated daily according to player and coach feedback.
Questions or issues relating to the draw should be submitted by e-mail to matt@tkdnsw.org.au and will be considered if received before 5.00 PM on Thursday 15th March 2012.
There will be no variation to the draw on the day of the tournament.

Awards: All events recognise 1st and 2nd place with Gold and Silver medals. All other competitors receive a participation medal.

Safety Equipment: Sparring competitors must wear WTF approved equipment -

- Trunk protector – the full colour style.
- Groin protector - (optional for females)
- Shin and Arm guards.
- Head guards (matching colour or white).
- Gloves - Compulsory for athletes 14 years and over (optional for junior athletes)
- Mouthguards are compulsory and must be white or clear.
- Shinpads which cover the instep (although not recommended) are allowed. Please note that the Taekwondo Australia



National Championships is a separate event with slightly different requirements.

Uniforms: A Taekwondo Australia badge on the left sleeve is compulsory for all competitors. No other national association badges permitted.

Coach registration: All coaches must have Taekwondo Australia Coach Accreditation and will be required to present their current TA Coaching Accreditation card.

We ask that your club provides sufficient coaches to avoid the possibility of players being disqualified due to unavailability of a coach when the player is called. Please note that, under WTF rules, a maximum of three (3) calls to the field of play will be given. Players not in attendance with their coach will be disqualified. Coaches are required to attend briefings.

Liability: All participants in the tournament take part at their own risk. The organiser can under no circumstances be held responsible for any damages, injuries, or loss to individuals or equipment.

Privacy: Personal details collected are solely for the purpose of the competition involved. Health information (regarding existing conditions/allergies etc) is for our records only and will not be disclosed to first-aid personnel or any other party.

Uncontested Players: Uncontested players may elect to receive either a medal or a refund. Players wishing to receive a medal are to present in full uniform when directed.

Refund Policy: Refunds are issued to head instructors after the event.

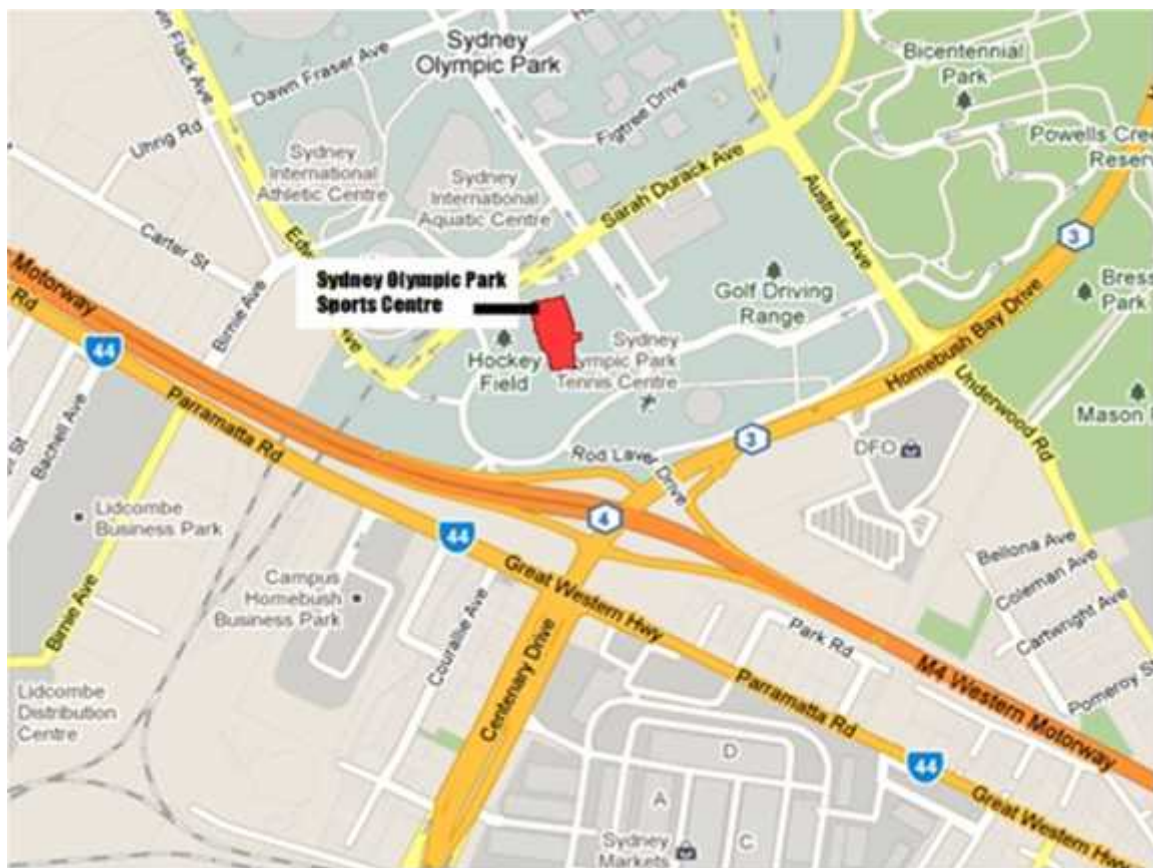
Minimum acceptable dress during weigh in will be T shirt and shorts with a 0.5kg allowance.
