Seminar Outline

This seminar is designed for Taekwondo Australia Poomsae Coaches and Athletes with a minimum grade of Red Belt – 10 years and above, who compete in Poomsae events. Grand Master Kim will conduct a one day intensive seminar, with practical sessions overviewing competition rules and scoring and lead practical sessions on required poomsae forms. Attendees will emerge from the seminar with a better understanding of how poomsae is scored and gain a competitive edge.
